A group of individuals supporting Abigail Spanberger will be providing transportation to those who need a ride so they can register to vote, cast their vote, or deliver their ballot to a county drop box.

Rides will begin **Monday, October 5th, 2020.**

PASSENGER REQUIREMENTS:

- Have not had any COVID-19 symptoms in the past two weeks. COVID-19 symptoms include: fever, cough, runny nose, lack of ability to taste or smell, nausea, vomiting, diarrhea, muscle aches.
- Have not had contact with someone having COVID-19 symptoms within the past two weeks.
- Be able to safely and independently walk to and enter the vehicle without assistance. (Drivers are all volunteers and unfortunately do not have the training to assist those who need extra help.)
- Preferably have access to a cell phone in order to send text images of your pick-up location to the driver.
- Preferably have access to a cell phone in order to receive texts from the driver.

SAFETY PRECAUTIONS:

- Driver and passenger must wear masks at all times.
- Driver will sanitize masks at all times
- Windows will remain open (weather permitting)

A NOTE ON ACCESSIBILITY FOR VOTERS WITH DISABILITIES:

- If you are 65 or older or have a physical disability, you may vote early at your registrar or on Election Day without leaving your vehicle. This is called curbside voting. Your driver can park the vehicle in the designated curbside voting location of the polling place and an Officer of Election will assist you to vote.
- For those who prefer to enter the polling place, there is at least one voting machine accessible to voters with disabilities at each polling place.
- Virginia polling places, including early voting locations, meet state and federal accessibility standards. You can find:
 - Accessible parking spaces, Accessible entrances, Accessible voting booth with chair, Seating available for voters waiting to vote, Sufficient space for voters in wheelchairs, Notepads available to communicate in writing, Magnifier for election material and the ballot
