## **Former Rep. Brat Voter Discusses Healthcare in New TV Ad from Spanberger Campaign**

HENRICO, VA — Democratic nominee for Virginia's 7th Congressional District Abigail Spanberger released a [new television ad](#) today, featuring Goochland resident and mother Jody Cametas, a former Rep. Brat voter. In the new TV spot, Jody discusses her son's Type I diabetes diagnosis and how the lack of leadership in Washington has dramatically impacted her family.
