**Abigail Spanberger Designated a “Gun Sense Candidate” by Moms Demand Action**

GLEN ALLEN, VA — Today, Abigail Spanberger, a former CIA operations officer and Democratic candidate for Virginia’s 7th Congressional District, was recognized as a “Gun Sense Candidate” by Moms Demand Action. Part of Everytown for Gun Safety, the largest gun violence prevention organization in the country with more than four million supporters, Moms Demand Action is a grassroots movement of Americans fighting for new and stronger solutions to lax gun laws.

"Long before I decided to run for Congress, I was an advocate with Moms Demand Action working for gun violence prevention. This is a personal area of interest and advocacy for me, and as a member of Congress, I will take steps to address the issues at hand with real solutions," said Spanberger. "It is time our members of Congress work together to pursue common sense gun laws in our country."

The recognition by Moms Demand Action joins a growing list of organizations and individuals supporting Spanberger’s candidacy. Yesterday, Spanberger was endorsed by seven current and former Democratic county committee chairs within the 7th Congressional District, further solidifying her position as the primary frontrunner. Their support follows an upgrade of Democratic favorability in the district by [CNN](#), and a major national endorsement from EMILY’s List, the nation’s largest resource for women in politics.
