Abigail Spanberger Releases Second Television Ad, “Get Things Done”

GLEN ALLEN, VA — Today, Abigail Spanberger, former CIA operations officer and Democratic candidate for Virginia’s 7th Congressional District, released her second television ad. The 30 second spot reflects on how protecting Virginians’ access to affordable, quality healthcare originally motivated her to run for office.

In the ad, Spanberger states she knew she had to run for office, “when our Congressman took a party-line vote that would have cancelled health insurance for thousands of Virginians.” She further remarks that, “making it [health care] into a partisan battle, makes things worse.”

“Nearly every day on the campaign trail, whether it’s at a meet and greet, forum, or community festival, people ask about health care and how we can ensure all Virginians have access to affordable, quality care,” said Spanberger’s campaign manager, Dana Bye. “This issue, along with protecting Medicare and Social Security, and keeping our kids safe from gun violence, are what folks in the 7th District want to talk about, and Abigail, unlike Congressman Brat, is ready to listen and take action.”

The release of this ad follows increasing local and national support for Spanberger’s campaign. Since the start of 2018, Spanberger has been endorsed by EMILY’s List, End Citizens United, NARAL Pro-Choice America, and numerous elected leaders, including Virginia Delegates Dawn Adams, Debra Rodman, and Schuyler VanValkenburg, as well as Richmond Mayor Levar Stoney.
