Spanberger Statement on Revised Senate Healthcare Bill

GLEN ALLEN, VA -- *Abigail Spanberger, candidate for Congress in Virginia's 7th district, released the following statement in response to the most recent healthcare proposal by Senate Republicans.*

"The latest version of the Senate Republican healthcare bill demonstrates that our leaders in Washington are still not listening to us. The proposed bill would hurt those with pre-existing conditions, decrease Medicaid coverage for children and the most vulnerable in our communities, and cause prices to rise for older Americans. When Congressman Dave Brat voted in May for a healthcare bill that would cause prices to go up and millions to lose coverage, he put party priorities above the needs of the people, and helped pave the way for Senate Republicans to propose the same. These actions do not reflect the values of the people here in Central Virginia.

"Having served under both Republican and Democratic Administrations as a CIA operations officer, I know the importance of putting country before politics. Our legislators need to start listening to their constituents and working together to find common ground. Our families in Central Virginia deserve a representative who acts in the best interests of those she serves."
