Spanberger Campaign Releases New TV Ad, “Serve”

GLEN ALLEN, VA — Today, Abigail Spanberger, former CIA operations officer and Democratic candidate for Virginia’s 7th Congressional District, released her [first television ad](#). In the ad, Spanberger highlights her decision to not take corporate PAC money. “Too many Washington politicians serve special interests — or themselves.
